Under this agreement for 2017 Gin Gin State High School will receive

\$274,500*

This funding will be used to

- Increase student support and access to Information Communication Devices through the introduction of Bring Your Own Device "x" Scheme.
- Increased student attendance rates across the school.
- Maintain 100% Queensland Certificate of Education attainment for Indigenous students.
- Increase support for students to attain Queensland Certificate of Education in 2017 (target 95%).
- Increase student attainment in Reading. All Year 8 students to move at least one full year in Reading age by end of 2017.
- Increase student attainment in Numeracy. All students in Year 8 to move at least one full year in Numeracy attainment by end of 2017.
- Increased support for students with disabilities and learning difficulties to achieve goals which align to their Individual Education Plans or Individual Curriculum Plans.

Our initiatives include

- Developing teacher expertise in the use of a range of electronic devices and strategies.
- Dedicated staff positions and roles to address attendance.
- Dedicated staff positions and roles to liaise with parents and support students to achieve agreed goals in Reading.
- Dedicated staff positions to support students to continue to achieve agreed goals and school certification.
- Engaging the services of experienced teachers to release staff to prepare resources and materials for Year 8 Numeracy and Reading strategies.
- Engaging the services of experienced teachers to implement Reading and Numeracy strategies in Year 8.
- Allocating Teacher Relief Scheme and professional learning costs to support teacher professional learning in the areas of Reading, Numeracy, attendance, Art and Science of Teaching, Queensland Certificate of Education attainment and improving Upper 2 Band attainment.
- Engaging the services of trained support personnel to support students with social & emotional as well as mental wellbeing needs.
- The provision of resources for individual Reading and Numeracy programs targeted at Year 8 students.
- The provision of additional library resources to support Reading across the school.
